## They call you.

It is very unusual for the IRS to make it's first contact with you over the phone and they never demand that you pay taxes without giving you the opportunity to question or appeal the amount they say you owe. If someone calls you claiming to be the IRS and asking you to pay them money, immediately hang up. Call TIGTA at 800-366-4484. to report the call.





You recieve an email asking you to update your IRS Efile immediately. You can spot these scams by noticing they reference the websites USA.gov and IRSgov (IRS.gov with no dot). If you receive this email, do not click on any links and forward it immediately to phishing@irs.gov.
